SECTION 1. BEN FRANKLIN ACADEMY

MISSION

SECTION 2. BOOK DONATIONS

All book donations become property of BFA and may be disposed of at the discretion of the Administration.

ACCEPTABLE BOOKS

BFA can accept books that meet the following conditions:

- Fiction published within the last seven (7) years in good condition;
- Non-fiction published within the last seven (7) years in good condition; or
- Classic or popular older books (e.g., Dr. Seuss Books, Huckleberry Finn, etc.).

UNACCEPTABLE BOOKS

BFA will not accept the following books:

- Encyclopedias;
- Textbooks; or
- Books that are yellow, broken, damp, soiled, written in or have torn/missing pages.
