

Make Plans to Attend Ben Franklin Academy's 2017 BEN*efit* Bash "A Night at the Speakeasy"

Mark your calendars, invite your friends & family, and start planning now for this fun and exciting adults-only night out!

What is the BENefit Bash and why should I attend?

The BENefit Bash is our major fundraiser of the year. We are hoping to raise enough resources to construct an outdoor classroom. The outdoor classroom would be a roofed, fixed structure with open sides, student seating, and a stage area for teacher or student presentations. It would be open for use by all grades and would provide yet another differentiated, tangible learning environment for our students. Additional auction proceeds will go toward fulfilling various teacher requests throughout the year. Our goal is for the majority of the money raised from the auction to go directly toward benefiting our school and not toward auction expenses.

How can I get BENefit Bash tickets and how much do they cost?

You can purchase tickets online from Thursday, September 28 through Friday, October 27th at: <u>bfacademy.ptapal.com</u>. Tickets are on sale for \$50 per person from Thursday, September 28 to Saturday, October 14. Regular ticket pricing of \$55 will be sold Sunday, October 15 to Friday, October 20. Beginning Saturday, October 21, ticket pricing will be \$60. We will stop selling tickets at midnight on Friday, October 27. No tickets will be available at the door. Buy your tickets early and save!

What does the BENefit Bash ticket price cover?

Please note that purchasing a ticket to the BENefit Bash, but not attending the event, does not contribute to the needs of the school. The ticket price covers the cost of your dinner meal. This way, the majority of the money raised from the auction itself (our primary fundraiser of the year) goes toward benefiting our school and not toward auction expenses. So, come and enjoy dinner, check out the unique collection of cars on display, and have fun bidding on items to support our childrens' school.

What does my ticket include?

The evening will begin with a silent auction and will include dinner, dessert, a live auction, and access to the Vehicle Vault car museum.

Also, we have researched ticket prices at other school auctions in the area. We found, to our delight, that we are one of the least expensive ticket prices! We want to ensure that you are able to spend funds on the donated items and baskets so that we can all benefit BFA.

What is a "reserved table" at the BENefit Bash and how much does one cost?

- \$50 will hold the table only. Individual seats still need to be purchased (8 per table) so please make sure to invite friends to share your table.

Are drinks included?

Iced tea, water, and coffee are included in the ticket price. Soft drinks are available for a price at the cash bar. There will be two cash bars available; one on each level of the venue. What is a Class Basket and why should I donate?

Each class is assigned a theme which the room parents will communicated to classrooms on September 18th. Parents have been asked to give a suggested donation of \$10 per teacher. This donation helps a designated shopper from your class—usually the room parent—purchase items for your theme basket. These baskets will be available for auction at the BENefit Bash. Please sign up and be as generous as you can. Parent participation makes the difference! We appreciate all of your help.

What are Teacher Experiences?

Many of our fabulous teachers donate priceless items to the auction – time for your child to spend with his/her favorite teacher. These experiences range from an afternoon painting pottery, ice cream sundaes after lunch, or pizza and a movie. These items will only be available during the silent auction. Many teachers have indicated a specific date/time for their experiences. The winning bidder will work out times and dates with the teacher(s) directly. Many of these experiences also allow your child to choose a friend to attend with them.

What are Spectacular Socials?

These are auction items for a specified number of attendees at a set price. If you are interested in joining the group, simply add your name and bidder number to the list. You will pay the set fee and are guaranteed to be part of the fun. There are a limited number of spots for each Spectacular Social sign-up, so if you are interested in something specific, go early! These fun groups range from a fun Mama's & Margaritas night, Ben's Brigade Meat Fest, group exercise classes, or learning a skill.

Why are we having the BENefit Bash instead of the Fun Run?

We like to think of it as alternating fundraising opportunities. For 2017-2018 we'll have the BENefit Bash. For 2018-2019 we'll have something similar to last year's Fun Run. Everyone has a favorite fundraiser and this way we get to enjoy everything!

Why is the BENefit Bash in the fall instead of the spring?

There are several reasons we moved the BENefit Bash to the fall. One of the main reasons our fundraiser was moved was so that we'll be able to use proceeds from the auction to fund purchases for this school year. We all enjoy the rare opportunity for immediate gratification!

Another factor is venue. It is challenging to find a location that can accommodate our average attendance of 250 people; 500+ auction items; and a live auction. These venues are also the only locations that can hold large proms and weddings. Thus, spring is a challenging time period.

Additionally, we are hoping that by having the event in the fall, families can do a bit of holiday shopping in a fun atmosphere instead of having to turn November/December Date Nights into frantic trips to the mall.

What has the BENefit Bash done for BFA in the past?

Funds from the BENefit bash have purchased playground equipment, the rock climbing wall, the tech lab, thousands of library books, continued upgrades to our technology labs, provided teachers with equal shares of funds collected to purchase items for their classrooms. The list goes on and on.
