
How to log in and submit an assessment excusal:




## 4. Review parent acknowledgement.

	l understand Colorado requires all students enrolled in a public school to participate in state academic assessments as specified in the stat law. I also understand that Colorado provides parents the right to excuse their child from state mandated testing. C.R.S. 22-7-409 (d)(I)(A), READ Act (HB 12-1238), School Readiness (SB 08-212) CAP4K, and HB 15-1323
	I understand the accuracy of state accountability data is impacted when students do not participate. The true performance of my child's school and teachers will not be captured in the state-reported achievement and growth scores.
	I understand by excusing my child from specific state testing, my child and school will not receive this specific data to track progress.


6a. Review Your Request. All assessments you select for excusal will appear under the "Status" section.
