- Classic or popular older books (e.g., Dr. Suess Books, Huckleberry Finn, etc.)

UNACCEPTABLE BOOKS

We will not accept the following books

- Encyclopedias
- Textbooks
- Books that are yellow, broken, damp, soiled, written in, or have torn/missing pages.
