 - Welcome/Announcements/Mission/Vision

- Discuss Amendment 66
 - o PPR escalators includeFree and Reduced Lunch, EEL, and online students.
 - Douglas County tax payers likely would contribute more that they would receive in PPR funding.
 - After year one, funding amount may decrease in part because the Teacher Leadership Initiative is only guaranteed to be funded for one year per opponents. Supports say funds will be there.
 - Provides for immediate increase in funds in Douglas County. Under certain models/economic conditions, DSCS/BFA could potentially receive less than current PPR funding in the future.
 - Kindergarten funded at full time.
 - DCSD Board passed a resolution in opposition to the Amendement

 - Jason Sunahara moves to support the DCSD recolution and join in opposition OF Amendment 66.
 - Matt Matherly seconds the motion.
