- Will be moving major fundraising event to fall. We can't turn around and do a silent auction again in October. Currently Fun Run on calendar for October 25th.
- Open discussion
 - Move from Saturday Possibly Halloween and combine with classroom parties.
 - o Board concerns
 - Always have said we will not have BFA students solicit money
 - Instructional time 9&10 day programs cut into teacher/classroom time
 - Jacob Kent offers Incentives per family Boosterthon/Apex are per student
 - Discussion to remove one and group decided to remove Boosterthon group from consideration.
 - Tiffani to talk to Apex & Jacob to equally align program and PTO board vote to follow so we can submit to fundraising committee for final approval.
- <u>Boosterthon Justin Lambert, General Manager</u>
 - Company running Fun Run programs for over 12 years Focus is only fun runs
 - This year will be serving over 1,300 schools nationwide
 - Mission strengthen schools. Raise funds. Inspire students!
 - 9 day program Boosterthon Live. They run everything!
 - Begin with Pep Rally right at end of school day
 - Each student included regardless of donations they collect.
 Each have own access code to their personal website.
 - Every day the students will watch a 10-minute video including character lesson, physical activity and fundraising update.
 - Collection process
 - Sliding scale. Average \$120 per student. Est 850 students = \$102,000. With donations of \$120K the school would keep 59%.
 - Can get sponsors for shirts. Cost for custom shirts are around \$3 per shirt.
 - Theme "Rockin Town Live All About Community"
- Apex Mark, Nick "Quick Nick", Carrie (Jeffco PE Teacher), Shelly
 - o 2 week leadership & fitness program.
 - Local teams from our community.
 - All employees are salaried. Not paid commission based upon commission raised at event.
 - Daily lesson with students (5-8 minutes)
 - Deposit of \$1,500 generally (waiving for us this year)
 - 52% (School)/48% (Apex) split regardless of donations received.
- Jacob Kent
 - Been doing fundraising for 15 years. Knows how to help kids have fun! Ran vacation bible school for past 5 years.
 - o BFA Parent wants to keep as much money as possible in school
 - Customizable. Wants input from school.

- Team would be PTO volunteers! Kids will respond better to parent volunteers.
- Willing to put it out there get student body involved. Get knowledge out there about what money is being raised for. Make event at the end fun!
- o 70% return back to the school.
- His company started duck incentive program 5+ years ago.
- Family donations not per student! Incentives go to all students in that family.
- Donations would come in via cash/check in collection envelopes or via PTO store website.
 - PTO would have fees charged on credit card transactions via PTO store.
