






Comments from Parents Regarding Administration










Parent's comments on Teaching Staff

- 196 comments provided
- Noted Strengths 93
 - overall communication with teachers was helpful
 - emails and newsletters sent out by teachers were appreciated
- Areas for Improvement 74
 - not enough details or information provided on student homework
 - information from teachers was late-coming
 - parents were not welcome in the classroom
 - little face to face time with teachers
 - short duration and infrequent schedules of the parent-teacher conferences
 - 29 parent comments specifically spoke to the websites used by teachers with the majority of parents reporting that the websites were confusing, difficult to use and full of outdated information.


Parent's comments on Curriculum

- 44 comments provided
- Areas of Improvement
 - 34 reported that the curriculum was not challenging enough for their students
 - Specific curriculum lacking identified by parents focused on the reading curriculum – especially in the kindergarten program
 - Ability grouping
 - no true ability grouping
 - poor assessment of children for the ability groups
 - lack of communication between the school and parents regarding their child's placement and progress in these ability groups

18. The curriculum offered at BFA is more challenging than the curriculum offered at the school my child(ren) attended last year










21. The ability grouping system at BFA is effective for my child(ren)


Parent's Comments on Curriculum

- 100 comments provided
- Areas of Strength 34
 - 22 parents reported they were happy with the ability grouping at BFA
 - 12 parents stated they were happy with the overall curriculum
- Areas of Improvement -30
 - ability grouping was not challenging enough
 - their children were placed in the wrong ability group
 - no "true" ability grouping at BFA
- 12 comments on Kindergarten curriculum (7 positive, 5 negative)
- 10 comments on Math curriculum (8 positive, 2 negative)
- Other Comments
 - lack of communication from the school on the curriculum and the ability groups in which their child was placed
 - the 13 Virtues were not being incorporated into the curriculum at BFA
 - teachers were inconsistently implementing curriculum







Parents Ideas for Additional Volunteer Activities






28. The supplemental instructional resource materials available are adequate



Additional Suggestions Provided by Parents

- Overwhelming positive comments
- Majority of families expressed their gratitude to the board, teaching staff, and administration of BFA
- Areas of improvement
 - parking
 - carpool concerns
 - more streamlined communication
 - \$150 supply fee
 - need for more FTF time with the teaching staff

Additional Themes Noted Throughout Survey

- In addition to the significant themes noted in each question, more minor themes were present repeatedly throughout all areas of the survey
 - Keep information as streamlined as possible for school
 - Keep information as current as possible (Board notes, homework, school activities, volunteer activities)
 - Allow parents more in-class time

Implications & Recommendations of the SAC

- Extra curricular activities need to be added
 - Survey shows that sports, music and foreign language are popular requests
 - The majority of parents will pay up to \$100/semester for these activities
- Teaching staff needs to return parent phone calls and emails within 24 hours per BFA policy

Implications & Recommendations Continued

- Parents need additional opportunities to see their teachers face-to-face to communicate with teachers about their students progress (i.e. longer/more frequent parent teacher conferences, in-class volunteer opportunities)
- PTO Manager/Sign –up Genius may want to be reexamined. Parents cited it as a difficult system to use
- If Administration/Teaching staff feels the use of supplemental materials at home is important, additional information should be given to parents
