Methodology


- Survey administered online Feb 1st Feb 17th

2012-2013 Limitations/ Recommendations

- Response rate from 2012-2013 was 9%
- Limited recommendations

- One trend observed was dissatisfaction with homework load


Grade Level of Children of Responding Parents

Number of Children per Grade

















6th – 8th Electives




- K-5th Feedback:

 - Parents requested typing courses



Satisfaction with Homework K-5th




Satisfaction with Homework $6^{th} - 8th$




General BFA Areas Assessed






Top BFA Strengths
