 male involvement at school for various activities vs. just those promoted via Watch D.O.G.S.
- Information/recommendation to be taken back to Bob to let him know update (Becky will talk to Julia after Dave sends a couple of bullets)
- Potential to vote on it next month as bylaws mention oversight of Watch D.O.G.S program
