



How to Find your Student State ID

To find a student's state ID (SASID) number in Infinite Campus for DCSD, parents can log in to the parent portal, navigate to the "Student Information" section, and locate the SASID number. The SASID is a unique identifier assigned to each student by the Colorado Department of Education (CDE).

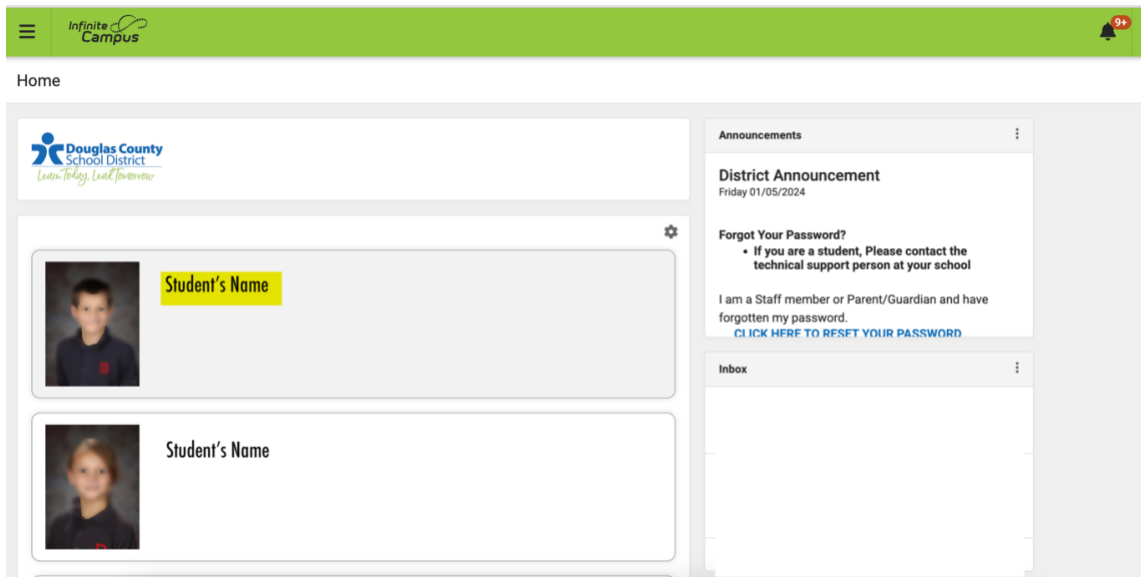
Elaboration:

1. Log in to the Parent Portal:

Parents will need to access the [DCSD Infinite Campus](#) Parent Portal.

2. Navigate to Student Information:

Once logged in, parents navigate to "Student Profile" section, often found by clicking on the student's name within the "Home" section.





3. Locate the SASID:

Within the "Student Information," the SASID number, also referred to as the state student identification number, will be displayed. It may be labeled as "State Student ID" or "SASID".
